How many medicine bottles can you collect?

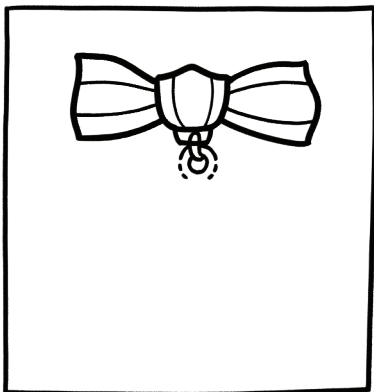
As you hunt for items in the gallery, colour in the medicine bottle every time you find an item or picture.

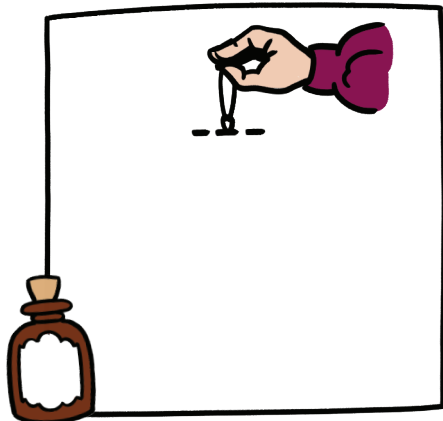
